## Key responsibilities

- As directed by senior staff, support residents who may require help with personal hygiene, dressing, toileting, food preparation and serving, laundry, shopping etc.
- As directed by senior staff assist in teaching/maintaining skills of residents to promote independence.
- Participate in planning the care for, and the review of, individual residents as appropriate.
- Have due regard to residents' well being, privacy, dignity, freedom of choice, physical, emotional, spiritual and social needs.
- Assist in the organising and the execution of entertainment, both in-house and external, for the residents and encourage their participation in local activities where appropriate.
- Liaise with senior staff to ensure a high standard of care is maintained at all times.
- Ensure all procedures and instructions in relation to Health & Safety are carried out properly and efficiently.

- Report on accidents, illness and defects within the building and surrounds to the senior person on duty.
- Ensure all paperwork required is accurate and complete.
- Have a commitment to undertake training as required.
- Participate in supervision/staff meetings.
- Carry out any other reasonable task as directed.
